## EVENT DAY

- Register at the red registration tents 7:00 a.m.–9:00 a.m.
- Pick up your packet at the red registration tents 7:00 a.m.–9:00 a.m.
- Drop off your pledges at the blue prize tents beginning at 7:00 a.m.
- Pick up your t-shirts at the blue t-shirt tents beginning at 7:00 a.m.
- Pick up your pledge prizes that you have qualified for at the blue prize and t-shirt tents beginning at 7:00 a.m.

## FOR YOUR SAFETY

- Dogs Only
- No cats or other animals, skateboards, bikes, or roller blades
- No aggressive animals or animals in heat
- No more than one dog per walker, please
- Multiple people may walk one dog
- All dogs must remain leashed throughout the event
- Retractable leashes must be locked in place to avoid tangling with others
- Dogs should wear current rabies and identification tags
- Walk the course only if you and your dog are conditioned for it
- Be prepared for strong lake winds and weather extremes
- Veterinarians and a medical response team will be on site
- Event officials reserve the right to refuse entry

# WAIVER

**No registration will be accepted without a signed waiver. Entries from minors will not be accepted without a parent or legal guardian's signature.**

I understand that participating in The Anti-Cruelty Society's BARK IN THE PARK includes an element of risk for both myself and my dog. I should not participate unless the dog and I are physically able and properly conditioned. I agree to abide by any decision of an event official relevant to the dog's and my ability to complete this event safely and I further agree that event officials may authorize necessary emergency treatment for me and/or my dog. I also understand that both vehicle traffic and spectators may be present along the course and I assume the risk of participating under such conditions. I further assume any and all other risks associated with participating in this event including, but not limited to illness, traveling to and from the event, falls, contact with spectators, other participants or dogs, the effects of the weather including temperature extreme and humidity, and the surface conditions of the roads, sidewalks, and footpaths, all such risks being understood and appreciated by me. I also affirm that the dog I will be participating with has current rabies vaccinations. I agree to abide by all rules of the event.

Having read this waiver and knowing these facts, and in consideration of this acceptance of my entry, I hereby for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators or anyone else who might claim on my behalf, covenant not to sue, and waive, release and discharge The Anti-Cruelty Society, Jim Brimm & Associates, The City of Chicago, The Chicago Park District, event officials, volunteers, and any other sponsors, suppliers, agents, independent contractors, employees and other personnel in any way assisting or connected with this event from any claims or liability of any kind whatsoever arising out of my participating in this event, even though the liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or parties named in this waiver.

I also understand that The Anti-Cruelty Society or any sponsor may subsequently use, for publicity or promotional purpose, my name or pictures of me or my pet without liability of obligation to me.
